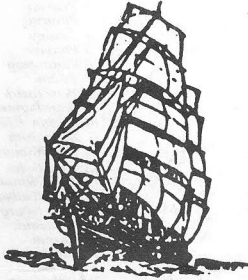

The registration mailer will reach you in March, with all the details about the speakers, consultants, costs etc. But you will probably want to plan your early summer travel now, to take advantage of the genealogy research facilities in Denver and Salt Lake City as part of your trip to "Denver '88".

The conference theme is "Gone West, Whatever Happened to Uncle Jakob?" The theme speaker will be Dr. Arlene Eakle, co-editor of The Source, who, in addition to the theme talk, will present two sessions on "Resources for Researching German-speaking Ancestors".

Other speakers will include Dr. Arta F. Johnson, author of Origins of German Surnames; Dr. John Luzader, retired U.S. Park Service historian; Edna M. Bentz, author of If I Can You Can Decipher Germanic Records; Donna J. Porter of Stagecoach Library; and Kenneth L. Smith, author and lecturer, Columbus, Ohio.

Consultants who will also be available in Exhibitors' Hall for personal inquiry will be Trudy Schenk, Salt Lake City, author of Wuerttemberg Emigration Index; Ernest Thode, Marietta, Ohio, specialist in locating European places of origin and surname searches; and Richard Mamon Photography, copying family photographs while you wait.

"Denver '88" will be a great conference in a lovely part of the world, with lots of nearby genealogical opportunities as well. Put it on your calendar!
